The Division 3 April meeting is SATURDAY, the 12<sup>th</sup>. We moved it because Easter falls on the day we would otherwise have met, and the Sunday before that is Palm Sunday. The meeting will be at the Kettering Recreational Center; a map is in this issue. Ron Dietrich will present a clinic on kitbashing buildings. Ron's layout includes an impressive city with many buildings of all sizes and shapes.

At the last meeting of the Division 3 Board of Governors (BOG), Lone Eagle Payne argued that we, members of Division 3, should be trying to influence the NMRA to be more friendly, more sociable, and more involved with modeling. Starting in April, we will have a tour of at least one member's layout after each meeting, at a location reasonably near the meeting place. Look for details in the *Call Board*. Bruce is going to arrange these, but he would appreciate having a helper. If you would enjoy being in frequent contact with other layout owners, call or write to Bruce. His contact information is in every issue of the *Call Board*.

Construction of the Scenic Ridge layout has begun. Actually, some of the members have

taken structures home to build. We will begin constructing the layout itself on Saturday, April 19<sup>th</sup>, at the Greene County Historical Society in Xenia. Look for a map in this issue of the *Call Board*. At the March meeting, we had initially decided to meet the first and third Saturday of every month, 1-5 p.m., to work on the layout. However, some members don't know how to get to the Historical Society, and this issue of the *Call Board* probably won't reach some homes until after the first Saturday in April. So, at the very end of the meeting, we decided to skip April 5<sup>th</sup>. A couple of folks left the meeting early. If you're one of them, we apologize for any inconvenience we caused you with the last minute change.

Dick Strous, of the Greene County Historical Society was the instigator and coordinator who arranged for us to have access to the Historical Society's facilities for this project. Thanks Dick. We are indebted to you and the Society.

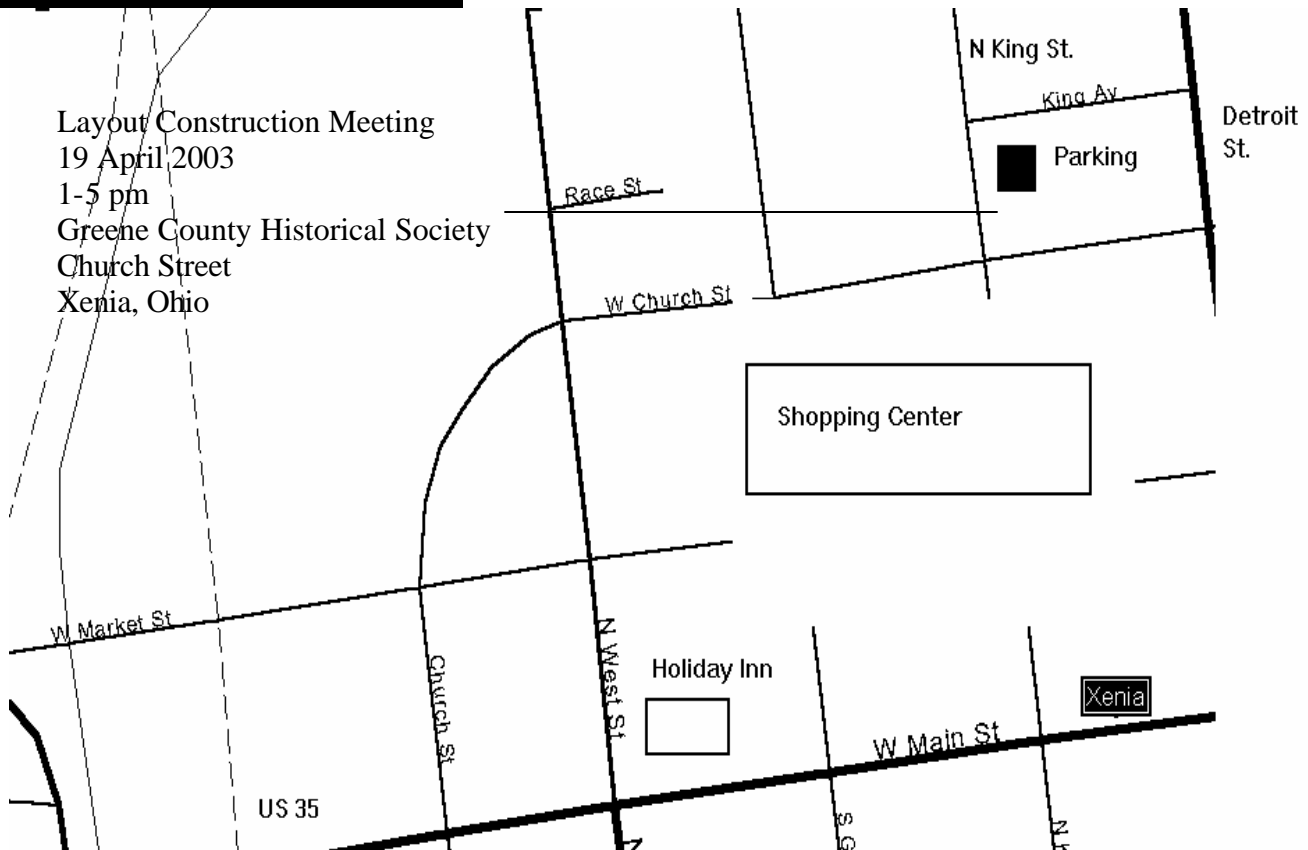

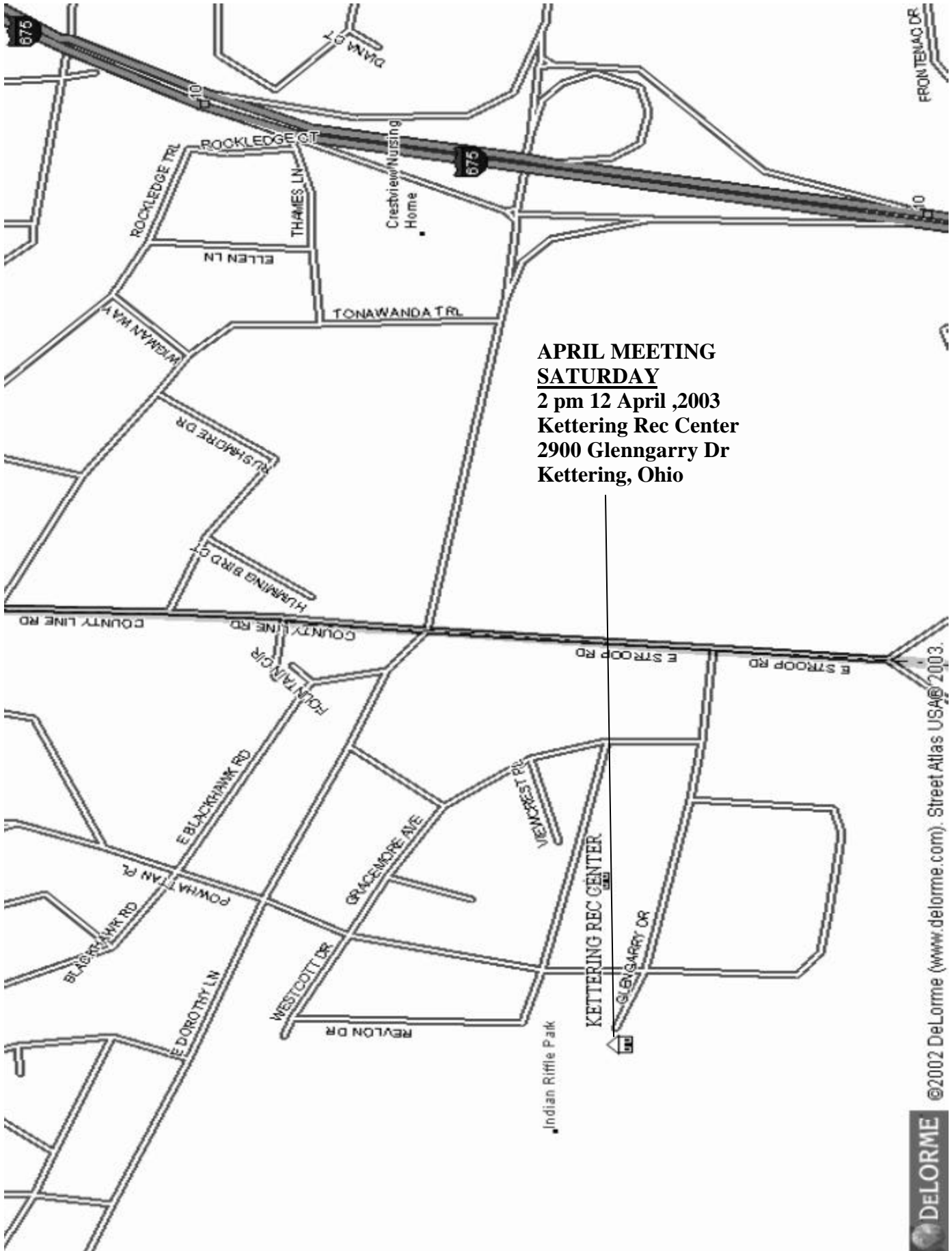
