

Only NMRA Members may enter items to be sold.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. To be eligible, the seller must have auction items and completed forms on the designated tables by 1:45 PM.
2. Each item entered in the auction must be tagged with a code number formed by the owner's initials and the item number from this sheet.
3. Items will be sold in the order that they are listed.
4. Each item that is to be sold as a separate item will be listed on a separate line and be assigned its own item number.
5. A brief but accurate description must be given. This description must include the operating condition if the item is powered or has moving parts. If any modifications have been done they should be noted if they are not readily apparent.
6. If there is a minimum acceptable selling price, it must be entered in the Reserve column.
7. At the conclusion of the auction, the sellers will collect their proceeds from the auction clerk.
8. For simplicity's sake minimum price is \$1.00 and all bids must be in whole dollars. Items may be grouped to meet these requirements.
9. The "Chief Runner" will manage the rotation of items to ensure that items from each seller is included.

Only NMRA members may bid on items.
